1) persons with the University Bachelor Degree in Business and Public Management or Economics; 2) persons with the University Bachelor Degree in other fields of studies, having completed bridging courses of 20 ECTS; 3) persons with the Professional Bachelor Degree and, depending on the field of completed studies, having completed the additional fixed volume studies or having not less than 3 years of the practical experience in the public sector, in leading positions (it is needed to provide a certificate about the practical experience). Applicants must have at least B2 level* of English according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.

ATTENTION!

Applicants having no the University Bachelor Degree in Business and Public Management or Economics must to complete bridging courses: State Management and Administration Systems, Management, Microeconomics, Basics of Law.
